

CALL FOR PAPERS

Symposium on Short Wave Infrared Imaging and Spectroscopy

25 September 2019, Amsterdam, The Netherlands

SWIIMS aims to bring together diverse researchers interested in spectroscopy and imaging in the short wave infrared wavelength range, from 780 – 2500 nm. Academic and industrial researchers are invited to participate in this symposium to present their research and discuss recent developments, from various application perspectives. Example topics include calibration modelling, image analysis and instrumentation, while application areas range from food/agriculture to pharmaceutical/biomedical.

This one day symposium will be held as part of **SpectroExpo** 2019 in parallel with the **WHISPERS** meeting. Participants will also have access to the **WHISPERS** programme, as well as having sufficient time for indepth, dedicated discussions with leading researchers and equipment providers from **SpectroExpo**.





Proceedings will be published on IEEE Xplore following peer review as part of the WHISPERS proceedings.

People are invited to submit new research results on the following suggested topics:

- Near infrared spectroscopy
- Short wave infrared hyperspectral imaging
- Predictive modelling with NIR data
- Macroscopic SWIR reflectance or transmission imaging
- Microscopic SWIR reflectance, transmission or darkfield imaging
- NIR/SWIR Instrumental design
- New chemometric methods for NIR data analysis
